This is where "industrial ergonomics" is needed, i.e. ergonomic risk management that adapts flexibly and quickly to changing requirements in terms of volume and production mix. Ergonomics and industrial organisation are the indispensable prerequisites for increasing the competitiveness of medium-sized companies.

The solution: the EAWS assessment tool

The aim of the webinar is to help small and medium-sized companies in Italy and around the world to meet the above-mentioned challenges and to familiarize them with EAWS (Ergonomic Assessment WorkSheet), one of the most advanced tools for a comprehensive assessment of the risk of biomechanical overload.
