In order for employees to learn how to use and master the new technologies of Industry 4.0, work-oriented teaching and learning concepts must be developed and the appropriate framework conditions created. These concepts and framework conditions, such as a work organization in the company that promotes learning or digital training, were and are the subject of our research," describes Mühlbradt.

Personnel development on the shop floor

How are the demands on workers changing with increasing automation and digitalization? Which new functions and competences will have to be established on the shop floor in the future? How can workers be supported at their workplaces? Digital learning and digital assistance are meanwhile also an integral part of the MTM ASSOCIATION e. V.'s own training and consulting offers - up to the establishment of complete work-related training centres in industry, such as the example of Leopold Kostal GmbH & Co. KG in Lüdenscheid shows.
